### PERSONAL EVANGELISM

LHM-Cambodia traveled to three provinces to conduct door-to-door evangelism, sharing the hope of Jesus Christ through personal conversations and meaningful connections. In addition, a team of ministry center volunteers visited a local hospital four times to bring the Gospel message to bedridden patients. The volunteers listened to their stories, prayed with them, and offered emotional and spiritual support. Many of the patients were

far from home and feeling lonely or discouraged. LHM-Cambodia was grateful to bring comfort during difficult moments and to share the love and hope found in Christ.

### BIBLE CORRESPONDENCE COURSES

LHM-Cambodia's Bible Correspondence Courses (BCCs) continue to be widely appreciated by people of all ages. These courses introduce the Gospel to those who do not yet know Jesus and help believers deepen their biblical understanding as they grow in their faith.

Within one month, 200 new individuals enrolled in the curriculum while 163 other people completed the first course. LHM-Cambodia now has a total of 27 volunteers and recently distributed 200 BCCs to people of all ages throughout the country.



### Because of You ...

- The LHM team translated and posted their new Lenten devotions on Facebook.
- During a recent broadcast of LHM-Cambodia's radio programs, "Answer for Life" and "The Light of Life", 129 listeners called into the program in response to the messages. The ministry center referred 87 people to local churches, while 76 others expressed a desire to learn more about the Word of God.
- LHM-Cambodia is planning new puppet shows for two local schools to share the story of Jesus Christ with children.



### Ministry Impact

Vid is married with three children and raises ducks and chickens for a living. One of his sons recently died in a traffic accident, and Vid is now raising his grandchildren. Vid was raised in a non-Christian religious family, but when LHM-Cambodia volunteers visited him and shared the hope that can be found in a relationship with Jesus, he wanted to learn more. Vid now feels released from his burdens and has connected with a group of Christians in his province to continue to learn more about Jesus.
